

# 10 FUN FACTS ABOUT APPLES

1. More than 2,500 varieties of apples are grown in the United States, but only the crabapple is native to North America.
2. Apples contain no fat, sodium or cholesterol and are a good source of fiber.
3. Apple trees take four to five years to produce their first fruit.
4. Apples ripen six to ten times faster at room temperature than if they are refrigerated.
5. Apples varieties range in size from a little larger than a cherry to as large as a grapefruit. The largest apple ever picked weighed 3 pounds.
6. Apples harvested from an average tree can fill 20 boxes that weigh 42 pounds each.
7. Apples are a member of the rose family.
8. The top apple producers around the world are China, United States, Turkey, Poland, and Italy. Apples account for 50 percent of international deciduous fruit tree production.
9. A peck of apples weighs 10.5 pounds. A bushel of apples weighs about 42 pounds.
10. It takes about 36 apples to create one one gallon of apple cider.

*Directions from Green Bay:*  
Take 29 east to Bonduel exit, turn left onto 47, go 6 miles south and turn left onto Landstad Road. Second farm on the right. Watch for signs!

*Directions from Appleton:*  
Take 47 north to Black Creek. At stop light, go north on 47 about 12.6 miles, turn right onto Landstad Road. Second farm on the right side. Watch for signs!

## Who Are We?

We're a small, farmer owned CSA farm located in Northeastern Wisconsin. We have 120 acres of farm land, 1.5 acres of garden and 3 acres of orchards.

## What is CSA?

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is a partnership between a farm and a local community of supporters.

## How often will I receive product?

Typically once the season begins, which is mid June, you'll receive produce once a week for at least 15 weeks. We'll deliver your share of fresh-picked veggies and a fine selection of herbs to a designated pickup site at Maplewood Meats (on HWY 29, just 12 minutes west of Green Bay), or on the Farm in Bonduel.

### Our tentative delivery dates are:

Pickup at Farm: Wednesdays & Sundays: 3-5  
Pickup at Maplewood Meats: Thursdays: 3-4

Our Produce will vary, based on what's ready for harvest and will range from a few pounds to over 20 pounds at the peak of the season. Just remember you'll have fresh food from the farm. No need to worry about where your produce is coming from.

## What benefits can I receive from membership?

Being involved with CSA operation always means sharing the rewards as well as the risks of farming.

### The benefits of membership in our CSA include:

- Enjoying the freshest produce available. We typically will harvest it the same day you will receive it.
- Knowing where, how and by whom your food is being produced.
- Having a direct connection with the people who produce your food.
- Supporting the kind of stewardship that is good for the land as well as its people to ensure it will be available for future generations.

## What are the risks of a CSA membership?

The risks include weather and pests. As a CSA member you're now sharing the risk of farming with us. Just as you'll reap the rewards when the weather cooperates, you now share in the risk of too much or too little rain, too hot or too cool of a growing season. While we do our best to raise diversified crops so while the lettuce may bolt early, the peppers like the extra hot sun and will thrive. Overall, we hope to bring you fresh produce week after week!
